### **Student Registration**

'My Sailor' is an online tool for individual members and On Board participants to update their own contact information, log activities and enter classified advertisements. 'My Sailor' is password protected and all financial Yachting Australia members will receive a logon and password with their membership card or Certificate. On Board participants will receive their logon and password with their On Board participation card, which should be mailed shortly after registering for a Yachting Australia Training course. Only personal details can be accessed through My Sailor, so it is important to keep your logon and password private. You can change your password in the My Sailor facility, once you have logged on the first time. Yachting Australia is committed to the protection of your personal information. YA logbook

- ✓ Residents of Australia not intending to move
- ✓ Not sailing regularly overseas
- ✓ Students who require a power boat license.

RYA logbook

- ✓ Residents of Europe or the UK
- ✓ Require International qualifications

On completion of the practical and the theory lesson of Keelboat Set Sail course, the YA introductory certificate is mailed to you direct from Yachting Australia. Please drop your logbook into our office on course completion of each course with your current mailing address. Logbooks are completed by the Chief Instructor and mailed to you in the first week of each month.

### **Insurance for Students in Yachting Australia Training Schemes**

Students undertaking a Yachting Australia Training Scheme at a Yachting Australia Training Centre or other recognized organization, aged between 5 and 85, have the benefit of a Personal Accident policy. This applies while undertaking training, while on the premises of the training organization and provides limited cover while travelling between activities. The cover includes death and disability compensation, non-Medicare medical expenses and, for income earners, and accident weekly benefit. The policy is arranged by OAMPS Insurance Brokers, via their marine insurance specialists Gault Armstrong, and is provided exclusively to students attending training at a Yachting Australia Training Centre. Students who get crew positions on non sailing school vessels are not covered by the above Insurance.

We strongly recommend that before you start crewing that you apply for Insurance for crewing. Many Owners and Skippers now ask for your YA membership Card to ensure that you are covered.

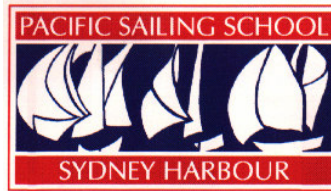

## **Yachting NSW Crew Club Membership**

Yachting NSW advocates club membership throughout NSW and encourages all sailors to become members of an affiliated sailing club.

Many sailors from overseas, or sailors who are members of Clubs which are not affiliated with a MYA's (Member Yachting Associations) crew at regattas during the season and regularly race and are not members of YA (Yachting Australia)

The Yachting NSW Crew Club membership enables sailors who are not members of an affiliated sailing club or overseas to be members of Yachting NSW thus allowing them to compete under the RRS 55 and to enjoy some of the benefits of individual membership.

This level of membership is also a service available for clubs to help ensure these sailors comply with the RRS 55 and other Racing Rules which protect the participants while participating in Club/State/National events.

Crew Club is supported by a few clubs in NSW. In order to obtain a Crew Club membership, sailors must find a club to sponsor them. All initial Crew Club applications are processed by the sponsoring club for the first financial year.

## **Benefits of Crew Club**

- ✓ Eligibility to compete in events and races through compliance with (RRS) Rule 55
- ✓ Personal Accident Insurance to the value of \$50,000 for those aged between 5 and 85.
- ✓ A membership card providing confirmation of your Yachting NSW Crew Membership number and discounts to a range of goods and services.

## **RRS Rule 55**

*"Any crew member that sails in more than three races in any one sailing season, shall be a member of a Club affiliated to an MYA, and be a Youth or Silver member of their MYA and Yachting Australia." (The term "MYA" means the appropriate member State/Territory yachting authority of Yachting Australia). "It shall be the responsibility of the person in charge of the boat to ensure that all crew members on board for each race comply with this prescription."*
