

Meridian Airlie Beach Race Week 12-19 August 2010

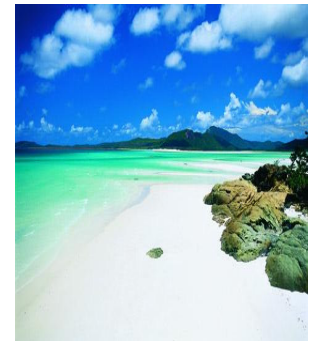


Formerly known as Hogs Breath Race Week, this event is now in its 20th year. The race week is based out of Abel Point Marina about 10 mins walk to the metropolis of Airlie Beach. There are six race days with a lay day during the week. The fleet grows every year and 2010 is likely to be no different.

Racing takes place from Pioneer Bay just outside the entrance to Abel Point Marina and starts between 10 and 11.30am each racing day. The course varies every day with short races around the Islands.
